On April 5, 1989, Paul Janszen was contacted by BRI Investigator Joseph E. Daly and he furnished the following information:

He went with Tommy Gioiosa twice in October - December, 1986, to meet Ron Peters. He remembers on one of the trips Peters was driving a Blazer type vehicle. Gioiosa was driving a Black Corvette. Gioiosa was paying off football bets to Peters. Janszen remembers Gioiosa counted out cash in the thousands before leaving the car to meet Peters in Peters' vehicle. When Gioiosa came back he didn't have the money. Janszen said he owed about \$500 in bets of the thousands Gioiosa was paying.

Janszen can't remember any details concerning the second trip with Gioiosa to see Peters, but the reason for the trip was the same, to pay Peters for betting losses.

Gioiosa was placing bets for Pete Rose and Gioiosa kept saying to Janszen, "Paul, you've got to talk to Pete. He's going broke".

He has no knowledge of Ron Peters using or selling cocaine. The FBI told him Peters was a drug distributor but during the investigation they found out he wasn't.

Janszen remembers someone taking bets for Peters when Peters wasn't around. He believes Peters said his name was Norman. Peters told Janszen to call Norman at phone number 424-1194 when Peters was out.

Janszen also placed bets with Ron Peters' sister, Sherry, at phone number 746-5636.

Janszen talked to Ron Peters' father on the phone and met him once but doesn't remember ever placing bets with him.

Janszen never placed bets with Ron Peters' wife.
